The family:

- Muldebere has 2 older sisters and one younger brother. Her father has passed away. Her Mother is HIV+ and Muldebere has never been tested. Her mother is receiving medication and treatment for the virus. We encouraged the mother to get Muldebere tested during this interview.
- Muldebere's mother is a believer attends the Good Samaritan Program on Friday's at Addis Kidan Church. She prays that Muldebere will become a believer.
- Muldebere's mother is a beggar. She looks for leftover food in the garbage dump. Sometimes they go without food for 4 or 5 days. Mother has remarried. He carries heavy loads on his back at the market. He earns 4 to 5 birr a day working. Their rent is 100 birr a month for a small mud and straw home with a tin roof. They have no other income.
